Without Sufficient Merit

The article reviews Rule 2:11-3(e)(1)(E), which provides authority for the Appellate Division of the Superior Court of New Jersey to dispose of an appeal without a written opinion under certain conditions. The Rule, which has been invoked by the Appellate Division with increasing frequency, serves as a reminder to appellate lawyers to avoid frivolity and focus their attention and briefing upon the most substantive and meritorious arguments available.
