## Day Pitney Sponsors "40 Women for the Next 40 Years" to Honor Outstanding Connecticut Women

"We're really looking for women who are not the managers or directors or executives, but rather those who are future leaders and women to watch," said Alice Pritchard, Executive Director at CWEALF. "We're seeking to honor women who go beyond their job descriptions and beyond the expected."
