Day Pitney Partner Naju Lathia Recognized with SABA New Jersey 2022 Young Lawyer of the Year Award

Naju R. Lathia earned her J.D. from Benjamin N. Cardozo School of Law, and her B.A., *summa cum laude*, from Rutgers University. She is admitted to practice in New Jersey and New York.
