CT AIDS Resource Groups Merge with the Help of Day Pitney

Day Pitney LLP attorney Lane Watson provided pro bono representation to AIDS Project Hartford (APH) in its recent merger with Connecticut AIDS Resource Coalition (CARC) to become AIDS Connecticut (ACT). The two nonprofit groups both provided services to people living with HIV/AIDS, and the merger will help to integrate and enhance the collective services ACT can provide to continue the legacies of APH and CARC and make an even greater impact on the community.
